Madison Police Department staff personnel have finalized data entry for the year 2013. The attached report is what is commonly referred to as the "UCR" crime report. This is the report, which is furnished to the (FBI) Federal Bureau of Investigations on a national basis concerning what is classified as the (8) eight major crime categories or "Type 1" crimes. The Madison Police Department considers this report an important measuring tool, which we use to gauge manpower and equipment resource deployment, crime prevention techniques and methods, and crime detection/suppression tactics.
