On May 22, 2014, Investigators with the Madison Police Department executed a search warrant at 1675 Lakeland Drive Jackson, Ms and 109 Cherry Laurel Lane Ridgeland, Ms in connection with an ongoing investigation related to the photographing of a vulnerable adult resident at St. Catherine's Village in the City of Madison, Ms. During the course of the investigation, officers arrested Mark Stevens Mayfield of Ridgeland, Ms and charged him with one count of Conspiracy to Photograph or Film Another without Permission where there is an Expectation of Privacy. Judge Dale Danks set Mark Mayfield's bond at \$250,000.00 dollars and he has waived his preliminary hearing and posted a cash bond. Also arrested in connection with the investigation was Richard Allen Sager of Ellisville, Ms. Sager is charged with one count of Conspiracy to Photograph or Film Another without Permission where there is an Expectation of Privacy and one count of Tampering with Evidence. Judge Dale Danks set Richard Sager's bond at \$250,000.00 per count for a total of \$500,000.00 dollars. The date of Sager's preliminary hearing has not been set at the time of this release. 
Hattiesburg, Ms was arrested in connection with the investigation and he was charged with two counts of conspiracy to include the Exploitation of a Vulnerable Person and the Photographing or Filming of Another Person without Permission where there is an Expectation of Privacy. John Mary was released on his own recognizance due to extensive medical conditions after consulting with his attorney and the Madison/Rankin County District Attorney's Office. Charges on the individuals were formulated and filed after consulting with District Attorney Michael Guest and other members of his staff along with the City of Madison Prosecutor Trae Sims. Prior to Clayton Thomas Kelly's preliminary hearing, officers of the Madison Police Department served him with additional warrants for Photographing or Filming of Another Person without Permission where there is an Expectation of Privacy and Conspiracy to Photograph or Film Another Person without Permission where there is an Expectation of Privacy. Kelly's total bond was set at \$200,000.00 by Judge Dale Danks. The result of the preliminary hearing on the count of Exploitation of a Vulnerable Person was that the court found sufficient evidence to forward the case to the Madison/Rankin County District Attorney's Office for review by the Grand Jury. A date of presentation has not been set and the investigation is ongoing.
