On April 16, 2021 at 0234am, a member of the Madison Police Department's Criminal Interdiction Unit conducted a traffic stop on a Chevrolet Malibu on Interstate 55 NB near the 109 mile-marker for a traffic violation. While speaking with the driver, the officer could smell the odor of marijuana. A further investigation revealed 16 Kilograms of Cocaine, approximately 20 grams of marijuana, 14 Adderall pills, and 18 Ecstasy pills inside the vehicle. Officers arrested Cedric D. Jackson of Prairieville, Louisiana and Nicole Danielle Martin of Addis, Louisiana. Both individuals are charged with trafficking a controlled substance, possession of a controlled substance and possession of marijuana. They were transported to the Madison County Jail where they will be held until their initial appearance in the City of Madison Municipal Court. The case will be forwarded to District Attorney John "Bubba" Bramlett for prosecution and no bond has been set at this time.

The street value of the cocaine is estimated at \$480,000.00
