INTRODUCTION AND ATTENDANCE

The first regular monthly meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Madison, Mississippi was held on Tuesday, January 3, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Municipal Courtroom at the Madison Justice Complex.
