Updated Press Release on Arrest for Animal Cruelty, Transporting Dogs for Purpose of Dog Fighting

On October 4, 2022 a member of the Madison Police
Department's Criminal Interdiction Unit conducted a traffic stop
on Interstate 55 in the City of Madison, MS. The result of the
stop was the seizure of 11 dogs that investigators believe were
part of a larger scale dog fighting ring. The dogs seized were
either transported for the purpose of dog fighting or being
breed for the purpose of fighting. The Madison Police
Department is currently still investigating this case; however,
we are pleased to announce that through civil proceedings, all
11 dogs were declared property of the City of Madison. These
dogs will be vetted and available for adoption through the City
of Madison Webster Animal Shelter. Please keep in mind that the
Webster Animal Shelter will post pictures and updates in the
upcoming weeks regarding their availability.

A food drive is being sponsored this Friday December 9, 2022 by the Madison County Library System from 2pm-4pm at the Webster Animal Shelter and the available dogs will be there for visits.
