## Conspiracy to Commit a Crime and False Pretense Arrest

On March 25, 2025 at approximately 7:00pm, the Madison Police Department was notified by Kroger on Highway 51 that a customer, earlier in the day, had passed several counterfeit bills to purchase gift cards in the store. Officers with the Madison Police Department arrived on scene and were able to identify a suspect description along with the suspect vehicle. Officers also learned that these same suspects committed similar crimes at other Kroger grocery stores in the metro area and are currently in contact with each respected jurisdiction. The suspect vehicle was described as a Silver Kia Soul with a North Carolina tag and that information was then passed onto departments in Louisiana and Texas.

At approximately 11:00pm, the Madison Police Department was notified that the vehicle had been located and stopped by the

Smith County Texas Sheriff's Office where three suspects were taken into custody on charges in their jurisdiction.

The three suspects are identified as Alice Faye Fisher, age 67 of Fayetteville, NC, Marlita Aeysha Williams, age 45 of Hope Mills, NC, and Tylec Raquon Williams, age 26 of Hope Mills, NC.

The Madison Police Department has placed a hold on all three suspects. Fisher will be charged with Felony False Pretense and Felony Conspiracy to Commit a Crime. Marlitta Williams and Tylec Williams will be charged with Felony Conspiracy to Commit a Crime. All three suspects will remain in custody at the Smith County Detention Center as they await criminal proceedings there.

The Madison Police Department would like to thank the Louisiana State Patrol and the Smith County Texas Sheriff's Office for their efforts on bringing these individuals to justice.
