**Introduction and Attendance**

A Special Called Meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Madison, Mississippi was held at 2:30 p.m. on Thursday, October 5, 2023 in the Conference Room located at Madison City Hall, 1004 Madison Avenue, in Madison, Mississippi. Those present in the room were Mayor Mary Hawkins Butler, Aldermen Sandra Strain, Tawanna Tatum, Patricia Peeler, Paul Tankersley, Mike Hudgins, and Guy Bowering, and Assistant City Clerk Nathan Hanson. Alderman Janie Jarvis and City Attorney Chelsea Brannon were both present by telephone.

Notice of the date, time, location, and specific subject matter of business to be acted upon was given to each alderman at least three hours prior to the time fixed for the meeting, pursuant to Miss. Code Section 21-3-21.

Mayor Hawkins Butler called the meeting to order. The meeting proceeded as follows:

**AMENDED ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**


Mayor Hawkins Butler called the meeting to order. She explained that she has been in contact with representatives from Cherry Hill subdivision on Bozeman Road. Sixty percent (60%) of their residents have expressed the desire to be included in the City's current annexation proceedings.

After brief discussion, the motion was made by Alderman Tankersley to amend the Annexation Ordinance to include Cherry Hill. Alderman Bowering seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in favor of approval. Mayor Hawkins Butler declared the motion carried. There being no further business for discussion, the motion was made by Alderman Jarvis and seconded by Alderman Strain to adjourn the meeting. After a unanimous vote of approval, Mayor Hawkins Butler declared the motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
