INTRODUCTION AND ATTENDANCE

The second regular monthly meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Madison, Mississippi was held on Tuesday, December 17, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Municipal Courtroom at the Madison Justice Complex. Those present were Mayor Mary Hawkins Butler, Aldermen Tawanna Tatum, Patricia Peeler, Ken Jacobs, and Guy Bowering, City Attorney Chelsea Brannon, City Clerk/Director of Finance and Administration Susan Crandall and Chief Deputy City Clerk Lisa Winstead. Mayor Hawkins Butler called the meeting to order. After the invocation led by Alderman Ken Jacobs and the pledge led by Alderman Bowering, the meeting proceeded as follows.

PRELIMINARY PLAT - REUNION, WINCHESTER, PHASE II, BLOCK Z - Approved Community Development Director Kianca Stringfellow presented the preliminary plat for approval of 98 lots with a minimum square footage of 2,400, located in the Reunion Subdivision, Winchester Phase II, Block Z. She stated that the Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended approval of this preliminary plat. The motion was made by Alderman Bowering, seconded by Alderman Jacobs and unanimously approved by all Aldermen present. Mayor Hawkins Butler declared the motion carried.

STORM WATER PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION UPDATE

A presentation of the legally required Storm water, Phase 2 update by Paul Lanning of Allen Engineering was provided at this time. Mr. Lanning stated that all comments resulting from the audit had been addressed to the MS Department of Environmental Quality and an updated copy should be presented in the first quarter of 2020.

With no further business for discussion, Mayor Hawkins Butler asked for a motion to declare the meeting adjourned. Alderman Bowering made the motion to adjourn. seconded by Alderman Tatum and unanimously approved. Mayor Hawkins Butler declared the motion carried and the meeting adjourned and wished everyone a Merry Christmas.
