## MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALLED BOARD MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MADISON, MISSISSIPPI

**Introduction and Attendance** 

A Special Called Meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Madison, Mississippi was held at 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 11, 2024 in the Conference Room located at Madison City Hall, 1004 Madison Avenue, in Madison, Mississippi. ADOPTION FOR FY 2024 REVISED BUDGET AND FY2025 BUDGET

City Clerk/Director of Finance Susan Crandall presented documentation for consideration of the revised Fiscal Year 2024 budget and the proposed Fiscal Year 2025 budget. Following brief discussion, motions were made as follows:

Alderman Strain made a motion to adopt the revised FY2024 budget as presented. This motion was seconded by Alderman Tankersley and the vote was unanimous in favor of approval. Mayor Pro Tempore Bowering declared the motion carried.
