MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALLED BOARD MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MADISON, MISSISSIPPI

Introduction and Attendance

ADOPTION FOR FY 2023 REVISED BUDGET AND FY2024 BUDGET
