2023 Madison Christmas Parade | December 2nd at 9am Rules and Regulations

Registration form must be completed and returned by FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 17th.

- 1. Upon arrival, please check in at Ridgecrest parking lot to receive entry number. We ask that you proceed to numbered spot in the parking lot.
- 2. Timing is of utmost importance. Floats must arrive by 7:30 AM. All other entries must arrive by 8:00 AM. The Parade will begin promptly at 9:00 AM.
- 3. NO THROWING OF ANY SORT BY PARADE PARTICIPANTS IS ALLOWED. (You may HAND out candy, fliers, etc)
- 4. Children walking in the parade must be five years of age or older. Younger children must ride on a float, car, or truck.
- 5. The only live Santa in the parade will appear on the city float.
- 6. Judges will be in one location along the route.
- 7. To avoid gaps in the parade, proceed slowly and constantly.
- 8. Choreographed marching units are to stop no more than 30 seconds while performing.
- 9. We do not allow any entries for sole advertising purposes; you must be festive.
- 10. Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for Float, Dance Team, and Band, and an award for Most Christmas Spirit at closing ceremonies at the Caboose.

FAQ's

Parade route? 2 miles

How long does the parade last? We begin at 9am and the last float arrives around 10:45 to the Caboose, depending on the amount of entries.

What do we do with our floats when we leave the Caboose? There will be signs directing you on where to exit the parade route. We will have MPD present to assist with traffic needs.
