

Section 302.8.1 Parking of Vehicles

Parking of cars, trucks, SUVs, and motorized bikes, are prohibited from parking within the required front, side, and back yards except on a paved driveway or other hard surface area normally considered the driveway of the lot, parcel or tract. Such vehicles may be parked or stored in a garage or in a carport or in the driveway.

No motorized vehicles shall be parked in the grass and/or yard area—this includes the front, side, or back yard. All motor vehicles and motorized bikes must be parked on a paved driveway or other hard surface area normally considered the driveway of the lot, or in the garage and/or carport.

Section 302.8.2 Permit Required to Park Overnight

Parking of trailers, boats, truck campers, travel trailers, tent trailers, camping trailers, recreational vehicles, off highway vehicles, all-terrain vehicles, tractors, or other major recreational equipment on a paved driveway or other hard surface area normally considered the driveway of the lot, parcel or tract requires a permit from the City of Madison Building and Permit Department. A permit will not be issued by the City of Madison unless the applicant provides written approval from the applicant's Home Owner's association to the Building and Permit Department. Each item listed in this paragraph requires a separate permit. Permit(s) can be obtained at the Building and Permit Department in the City of Madison or on the City of Madison's Website.

If a permit is granted in order to park overnight, the trailer, boat, truck camper, travel trailer, tent trailer, camping trailer, recreational vehicle, off highway vehicle, all-terrain vehicle, tractor, or other major recreational equipment must be parked on a paved driveway or other hard surface area normally considered the driveway of the lot, parcel or tract.
